AY2010-2011 EGYPTIAN FULBRIGHT STUDENT PROGRAM

The Binational Fulbright Commission in Egypt (BFCE) is pleased to announce the opening of the competition for the **AY2010-2011 Egyptian Fulbright Student Program** which provides grant opportunities of up to two years for university graduates, masters and doctoral degree candidates, and young professionals and artists to study and conduct research in the United States.

GRANT TYPES

- Masters Degree Grants, for persons wishing to pursue postgraduate degrees in the U.S.
- Non-degree grants, for persons registered for advanced degrees in Egyptian universities who wish to conduct research in the U.S.
- Fine & applied arts grants for artists who wish to conduct field research or attend master classes with professionals in the U.S.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS

All fields are eligible except medicine, dentistry and veterinary medicine.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Egyptian citizenship; holders of U.S. green cards and/or passports are ineligible.
- Bachelor's degree. Minimum of "Good" for applicants in American studies, humanities, and social sciences. Minimum of "Very Good" for applicants in the sciences.
- Minimum of two years post-graduate experience.
- Minimum Institutional (Local-ITP) TOEFL score of 550 from AMIDEAST Egypt or its equivalent iBT, CBT or IELTS equivalent.
- For Fine & Applied Arts applicants: principal participation in at least three artistic activities or exhibitions; No TOEFL score required.
- For Non-Degree applicants: proof of registered masters or doctoral thesis at an Egyptian University.

ELIGIBLE FIELDS

Aeronautics and astronautics/aeronautical engineering, agriculture (theoretical or research-based focus only in areas as entomology, plant biology, plant pathology, and soil science), astronomy/planetary sciences, biology, biomedical engineering, chemistry, computer sciences/engineering, energy, engineering (electrical, chemical, civil, mechanical, ocean, and petroleum), environmental science/engineering, geology/earth and atmospheric sciences, information sciences and systems (engineering focus only), materials science/engineering, mathematics, neuroscience/brain and cognitive sciences, oceanography, public health (theoretical research focus only) and physics.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Egyptian citizenship.
- Bachelor's or master's degree in a relevant specialization from an accredited university with a minimum Grade/GPA of Very Good/B.
- Minimum Institutional (Local-ITP) TOEFL score of 580 from AMIDEAST Egypt or its equivalent iBT, CBT or IELTS equivalent.
- Strong academic background in the sciences.
